### **My Reading History !**



*Have you ever said this?*

*Oh no! I forgot to gather the bibliographic information from that book I just returned to the library. Now what do I do??*

No more worries. Tripod offers patrons the option of keeping a history of the items they check out. This service is for your convenience only and you must choose to activate it. You can opt out at any time. If you wish to have a running history of your library record, log into Tripod and click on the 'Reading History' button. This will take you to:

opt in

If you choose to activate this service, Tripod will automatically keep a running list of all the books, videos, music, etc. that you borrow from the libraries, even after you return them. You can easily remove individual items from the list, or clear the whole list with a few clicks -- just check the boxes and click "Delete Marked."

*The Tri-College Libraries are committed to protecting your privacy. However, if you opt into "My Reading History" the information contained in this file is, as is any part of your library record, subject to any judicial process (e.g. **the Patriot Act**). Once items are deleted from "My Reading History" they cannot be restored.*

\*\*\*A word of caution – YOU must remember to delete this information or it will remain a part of your record indefinitely.
